Dear Sheep of the Divine Shepherd:

When our Lord Jesus Christ teaches us to pray, God promises to hear and answer our petitions. The Prayer that Jesus Christ himself has given us teaches us on how to frame all our daily prayers. Unfortunately, because of our sinful flesh, there are many times we pray the Lord's Prayer and neglect to focus on what we are saying.

Let us look at a small portion of the Lord's Prayer. The Introduction. Our Father who are in heaven. What does this mean? With these words God tenderly invites us to believe that He is our true Father and that we are His true children, so that with all boldness and confidence we may ask Him as dear children ask their dear father. As adopted sons and daughters (Romans 8:15-16) we can be sure that our Father loves us and cares for us and so answers our prayers according to His will. Calling upon God as Father helps us to understand how to shape all our other prayers. We pray to our dear Father who wishes to always help us.

Our Father who is in heaven, is Creator, ruler of all, and all-powerful to grant us all that is good for us. Yet, also remember that it is not wrong to pray to Jesus or to pray to the Holy Spirit for they are all one God. We certainly pray in Jesus' name (that is, through faith in Him and accordance to His will.) (John 14:14).

We also know that we have received the gift of the Holy Spirit in Baptism. It is the Holy Spirit that gives us the power and the blessing to speak to Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Romans 8:26). Our Father, who art in heaven. Only you, the children of God have such a great privilege. You have a Father in Heaven who loves you and hears your praises, as well as your cries.
