Ladies Aid

Blue Side Banners

The messages and symbols on all of the banners were carefully chosen to reflect the Advent season. "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" is in reference to the traditional Advent hymn. Jesus is Emmanuel, which means "God with us." "Hope, Peace, Love, Joy" are the words that depict our focus during the four weeks of Advent.

<u>The Angel</u>: Angels play significant roles in the birth of Jesus. The angel Gabriel appeared to Mary to inform her she would be the mother of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. An angel came to Joseph in a dream to tell him he would fulfil the role of Jesus' father on Earth. Angels came to the shepherds to tell them the Savior had been born and Angels filled the skies with songs above Bethlehem to celebrate and announce the birth of Jesus.

The Candle: The candle reminds us Jesus is the light of the world. He, and He alone, is the light we should follow. Through Him we will find our way in the darkness of life. "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life." John 8:12

<u>The Star</u>: The star signifies the Star of Bethlehem, which was a divine sign, that shined on the night Jesus was born. This star led people to Jesus and the Magi called it "His" star. Jesus is also referred to as "the bright morning star."

Jesus is the gift that perfectly fits every heart, and it is with His love that all celebration starts. We rejoice in Him as we remember His birth and thank God for sending His only Son to earth. His life led from a manger to a cross on a hill where He faithfully followed His Father's perfect will. He freely laid down everything so that we could live, and there is no greater treasure anyone could give. Like a scarlet ribbon His love wrapped around the cross and He offered it to us all at the greatest cost. So each time that we give we remember what He's done and honor the perfect Gift—God's one and only Son. — Holley Gerth
